

Washington, D.C. — Congressman Earl Blumenauer (D-Ore.) will testify before the House Subcommittee on Economic Development, Public Buildings and Emergency Management tomorrow at 10:00 a.m. in 2253 Rayburn Building in Washington, DC regarding his opposition to GSA's renovation plans for the Pioneer Courthouse. The Public Buildings Subcommittee sets policy for GSA and is responsible for oversight of the agency.

Blumenauer has asked the Subcommittee to take action to prevent the General Services Administration (GSA) from moving forward with plans to add a parking garage to Pioneer Courthouse and evict the post office from the historic building as part of upcoming renovations to the building. Blumenauer secured \$16.6 million for seismic upgrades and historic renovations to the courthouse in 2001, and did not intend the much-needed funds to be used for constructing a parking garage.
