Dear Applicant,

Thank you for contacting me about your interest in applying to one of the United States Service Academies. Your enthusiasm to attend an academy and serve our country is encouraging and deeply appreciated.

Members of Congress nominate candidates each year for the service academies. I take this nomination process very seriously and ask for a considerable amount of information and effort to be provided by you, the candidate. The following is required:

- Application for nomination (form enclosed)
- List of extracurricular activities (form enclosed)
- Personal theme letter
- High School Evaluation form (form enclosed)
- One letter of recommendation
- High school transcript
- Your SAT or ACT test scores mailed directly from testing agency

You will also need to apply for admission directly to your preferred academies. When you have successfully completed this step, your name will appear on that academy's candidate list. If your name is not on the list, we not be able to process your nomination.

These materials need to be received in my office **no later than Friday, November 30, 2018.**

Instructions

1. **Residence:** Applicants must be a resident of Oregon and reside in the Third Congressional District to be considered for nomination by Congressman Earl Blumenauer. If the applicant is temporarily residing outside of Oregon, be sure to provide both addresses on the application form.
2. **Academy Preference:** Each applicant is considered for his or her first choice. However, in the event that an applicant merits a nomination and the first choice is not available, the applicant will be considered for his or her second choice.
3. **Method of Nomination:** Congressman Blumenauer uses the "competitive nomination" selection process for academy candidates. Using this method, ten nominations are submitted by our office to each academy. These nominees then compete at the academy level for the actual appointment.
4. **Documentation to be sent to Congressman Blumenauer**
 - A. **Application Form, List of Extracurricular Activities, and Personal Theme.** To be filled out by the applicant and returned to our office. The Application Form and Extracurricular Activity Forms are included with this packet. The Personal Theme is a short (200-word) essay explaining the applicant's motivation for attending an academy.
 - B. **High School Principal, Head of School or Guidance Counselor Evaluation Form**
To be filled out by the applicant's high school principal, head of school, or guidance counselor. In the case of home-schooled candidates, the principal/head of school/guidance counselor letter may be written by a relative.
 - C. **Letters of Recommendation**
Please send only one letter of recommendation. Recommendation letters must be from non-relatives. Additional letters of recommendation will not be considered.
 - D. **High School Transcript**
Transcripts must be in a school sealed envelope. If the applicant has graduated from high school, preparatory school, or college, a final high school transcript and transcript of advanced study should be submitted.
 - E. **College Entrance Examination Board Scores:**
The applicant is required to forward the results of his or her SAT or ACT exam to our office directly from the testing agency. Congressman Blumenauer's score codes are 4107 for the SAT and 7629 for the ACT.

Congressman Blumenauer is very aware of the importance of an academy nomination to the applicant, and each completed file is carefully considered on the individual applicant's own merits. To give time for a thorough evaluation of each file, it is crucial that all of the documentation requested be received in Congressman Blumenauer's Portland District Office **by November 30, 2018**. Applications can be mailed or hand delivered to Congressman Blumenauer's Portland office. Applicants with incomplete files will not be considered. The applicant can reach Congressman Blumenauer's military academy caseworker at 503-231-2300.
